Some of the eggs were numbered 1-6 and some had numbers with a special meaning:

- K: 1
- E: 2
- I: 3
- D: 4
- B: 5
- F: 6



H: 29 - the number of stores selling jewelry on South Franklin Street in May 2019

L: 36 - the number of musicians for hire listed on the Arts Council "gigables" list

C: 315 - the average number of days in a normal year that the JAH building is in use

J: 978 - the # of seats in the JDHS Auditorium, Juneau's largest performance venue

G: 1984 - the year that a purpose-built performing arts center was first added to the CBJ Comprehensive Plan

A: 10.3 million - The approximate revenue contributed to Juneau's economy each year by artists of all types (JEDC estimate)
